

Pastel Lattice by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 1 gram - Size 11 Opaque Sour Apple Luster Round Japanese Seed Beads by Toho - 131 (SB5665) **(A)**
- 67 beads - 3mm Alabaster Pastel Olivine Round Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL4392) **(D)**
- 9 grams - 2x5mm Opaque Gray Luster SuperDuo 2 Hole Seeds (SB4217) **(C)**
- 10 grams - 2x4mm Opaque Lilac Luster Peanut Japanese Seed Beads (SB3890) **(B)**
- 1 - 11x21.5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 3 Strand Tube Bar Clasp (BM3070)
- 1 - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread .006 diameter (SM4428)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Size 12 English Beading Needles (TL1647)
- Synthetic Beeswax, 2 ounces (TL1026)
- Xuron Thread and Fiber Scissors (TL3000)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Basic Right Angle Weave

Instructions to complete “Pastel Lattice” bracelet:

Tip

The letters A – D designate the beads used in the pattern. Please refer to the materials list above for the key. This bracelet is made with a variation of right angle weave using two-hole beads. If you are not proficient with right angle weave, please follow the Basic Right Angle Weave Technique and practice the stitch using conventional beads until you are comfortable with the stitch.

Step 1

Thread a needle with 5 feet of beading thread (add thread as needed), and wax the thread.

Step 2

String these beads in the following sequence:

1 – D

1 – B

1 – C

1 – B

Repeat the sequence three times. Leaving an 8-inch tail, pass through the first three beads strung. Pull tight.

Step 3

Exiting a C, turn and pass through the second hole in the C. Flip the Cs so that the second hole is on the inside of the circle.

Step 4

String 1 – B. Pass through the second hole in the next C. Repeat this step three times. Pull tight.

Step 5

Turn and pass through the outer hole of the last C exited. Weave through beads to exit the D on the end of the circle opposite the tail.

Step 6

String these beads in the following sequence:

1 – B

1 – C

1 – B

1 – D

Repeat the sequence twice, then string:

1 – B

1 – C

1 – B

Pass through the D from the previous unit. Pass through all beads just added, the D from the previous unit, and two more beads.

Step 7

Repeat Steps 3 – 5.

Step 8

Repeat Steps 6 – 7 for the desired length of the bracelet. Weave through beads to exit the D on the side of the circle, not the end.

Step 9

Repeat Steps 6 – 7. Weave through beads to exit the D opposite the end of the bracelet.

Step 10

String these beads in the following sequence:

1 – B
1 – C
1 – B
1 – D

Repeat the sequence once, then string:

1 – B
1 – C
1 – B

Pass through the D on the inside edge of the next unit. String:

1 – B
1 – C
1 – B

Pass through the D exited at the beginning of this step. Pass through all beads in the circle again, and then pass through the first two beads (Peanut Bead B, SuperDuo C) added in this step.

Step 11

Exiting a C, turn and pass through the second hole in the C. Flip the Cs so that the second hole of each is on the inside of the circle. * String 1 – B, and pass through the next C. Repeat from * four times. Pass through all beads in this round again. Turn and pass through the outer hole of a C. Weave through beads to exit the D opposite the end of the bracelet.

Step 12

This unit will be worked in the opposite direction from the previous unit. String these beads in the following sequence:

1 – B
1 – C
1 – B

Pass through the D on the inside edge of the next unit.

Step 13

String these beads in the following sequence:

1 – B
1 – C
1 – B
1 – D

Repeat the sequence once, then string:

1 – B
1 – C
1 – B

Pass through the D of the previous unit. Pass through all beads in this round. Pass through two more beads.

Step 14

Repeat Step 11.

Step 15

Continue to alternate, following Steps 10 – 11, then Steps 12 – 14.

Step 16

Clasp attachment: Exiting a D at one end of the bracelet, string 7 – A, and pass through the first loop on one side of the tube bar clasp (the loop should float over the beads). Pass back through the D exited at the beginning of this step. Reinforce the attachment by passing through all beads again.

Step 17

Weave through beads until you pass through the 2 Bs at the center of this end of the bracelet. In the same manner as in the previous step, string 7 – A and the second loop on the tube bar clasp. Reinforce as before.

Step 18

In the same manner as in Step 16, attach the second D on this end of the bracelet to the third loop on the clasp. Weave the thread back and forth through several beads to secure, and trim the thread.

Step 19

Repeat Steps 16 – 18 on the second end of the bracelet and the corresponding loops on the second side of the tube bar clasp.
