Approximate finished length: 7 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 44 - Swarovski Crystal Round Pearl Bead - 5810 - Scarabeus Green - 3mm (PL7374)
- 15 - 4mm Iridescent Purple Swarovski Crystal Pearl Beads (PL7318)
- 18 - 4mm Iridescent Green Swarovski Crystal Pearl Beads (PL7296)
- 28 - Swarovski Crystal Round Pearl Bead - 5810 - Scarabeus Green - 6mm (PL7377)
- 23 - 6mm Iridescent Purple Swarovski Crystal Pearl Beads (PL7320)
- 18 - 6mm Iridescent Green Swarovski Crystal Pearl Beads (PL7298)
- 17 - Swarovski Crystal Round Pearl Bead - 5810 - Scarabeus Green - 8mm (PL7378)
- 17 - 8mm Iridescent Purple Swarovski Crystal Pearl Beads (PL7321)
- 12 - 8mm Iridescent Green Swarovski Crystal Pearl Beads (PL7299)
- 6 inches - 3.5mm Imitation Rhodium Plated Brass Oval Cable Chain (CN5365)
- 1 - 25mm Rhodium Plated Pewter Medium Hammertone Ring by TierraCast® (SP2290)
- 1 - 16.25x13.5mm Rhodium Plated Pewter Maker's Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2525)
- 192 - 24 gauge Silver Plated Brass 2 inch Head Pins (BM2691)
- 2 - 4mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2747)
- 2 - 6mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2767)
- 2 feet - 26 Gauge Round Tarnish Resistant Silver Artistic Wire (AW2157)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire Wrapping
- Covering a Component – Surface
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Encircled in Pearls” bracelet:

Step 1

Anchor a 2-foot length of wire onto the hammertone ring component (see Covering a Component – Surface Technique). Cover the component with 23 3mm Scarabeus Green pearls.

Step 2

Cut the chain into two 3-inch lengths.

Tip

Beads will be used randomly in the next steps. Mix all remaining beads into a small bowl and select randomly from the bowl.

Step 3

Place any one bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to the first chain link on one 3-inch length of chain.

Step 4

In the same manner as in the previous step, wire wrap a second bead on the same side of the same chain link.

Step 5

Repeat Steps 3 – 4 on the opposite side of the same chain link, attaching a total of four bead units to the same chain link.

Step 6

Repeat Steps 3 – 5 with each of the remaining chain links.

Step 7

Repeat Steps 3 – 6 with the second 3-inch length of chain.

Step 8

Open one 6mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach one end link of one chain length to the component. Close the jump ring.

Step 9

Repeat Step 8 with the second chain length on the opposite side of the component.

Step 10

Open two 4mm jump rings. Use one jump ring to attach one side of the toggle clasp to one end of the bracelet, and the other jump ring to attach the second side of the clasp to the opposite end of the bracelet. Close both jump rings.
