

# Glistening Holiday by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches (circumference of 1 loop), 2.5-inch diameter

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 86 beads - 2.5mm Round Fire Polished Czech Glass Beads - Matte Metallic Flax (FP3917) (**A**)
- 44 - Preciosa Crystal Bicone Beads - Crystal Golden Flare 2X - 4mm (PC1084) (**B**)
- 41 - Preciosa Crystal Round Pearl Beads - Bordeaux - 4mm (PC9013) (**C**)
- 24 - Preciosa Crystal Round Pearl Beads - Dark Green - 4mm (PC9010) (**D**)
- 25 - Preciosa Crystal Round Pearl Beads - Bordeaux - 6mm (PC9057) (**E**)
- 30 - Preciosa Crystal Round Pearl Bead - Dark Green - 6mm (PC9054) (**F**)
- 1 - Round Memory Wire Bracelet - Gold - 2.5 inch diameter - 12 turns (SM5335)
- 2 - Round Memory Wire End Cap - Gold - 3mm (BM3570)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

- Xuron Memory Wire Cutter (TL3159)
- 5 Minute Epoxy (TL1938)



## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

None

**Instructions to complete “Glistening Holiday” bracelet:**

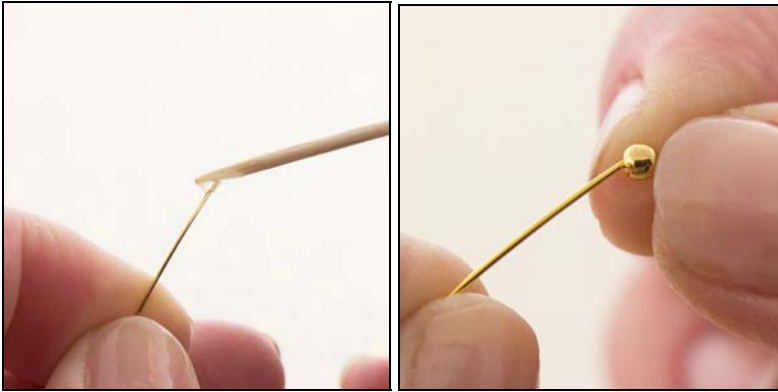
**Step 1**

Dispense a small amount of 5 Minute Epoxy according to the package directions, and mix with a toothpick.



**Step 2**

Using a toothpick or short length of scrap wire, apply a small drop of epoxy to the inside of one end cap. Insert one end of the Memory Wire into the end cap. Allow the epoxy to dry completely.



**Tip**

The letters A – F designate the beads used in the stringing sequence. Please refer to the materials list above for the key.

**Step 3**

String these beads in the following sequence onto the Memory Wire:

12 (2") – D  
29 (3") – A  
10 (2.5") – E  
12 (2") – B  
12 (3") – F  
12 (2") – C  
14 (1.5") – A  
8 (2") – F  
17 (3") – C  
20 (3") – B  
12 (2") – C  
29 (3") – A  
10 – (2.5") – F  
12 (2") – B  
12 (2") – D  
15 (4") – E  
14 (1.5") – A

**Step 4**

Trim the wire, leaving about a quarter-inch of wire after the last bead.



**Step 5**

Repeat Step 2 on the end of the wire.
