

Crystal Night by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 24 - Ruby Swarovski Crystal Bicone Beads - 5328 - 3mm – Ruby (03BI1111)
- 11 - Swarovski Crystal Oval Rivoli Fancy Stones - 4122 - Crystal Rainbow Dark - 18x13.5mm (SK2354)
- 11 - Settings for #4122 Swarovski Crystal Oval Rivoli Fancy Stone - Rhodium - 18x13.5mm (BM5252)
- 1 - Brass Magnetic Tube Bar Clasp - Silver - 14mm - 2 strand (BM0392)
- 4 - Precious Metal Crimp Bead - Sterling Silver - 2x2mm (SS4047)
- 4 - Precious Metal Crimp Bead Cover - Sterling Silver - 3.5mm (SS2103)
- 20 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .024" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0312)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping pliers (TL0500)
- Wire cutters
- Tapered Nylon Jaw Pliers (TL2468)



Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Using Swarovski Crystal Stones with Settings
- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “Crystal Dark” bracelet:

Step 1

Place one Crystal Rainbow Dark crystal oval Rivoli fancy stone into one setting. Using tapered nylon jaw pliers, gently bend the setting prongs around the stone to secure it.



Step 2

Repeat Step 1 with each of the remaining stones.



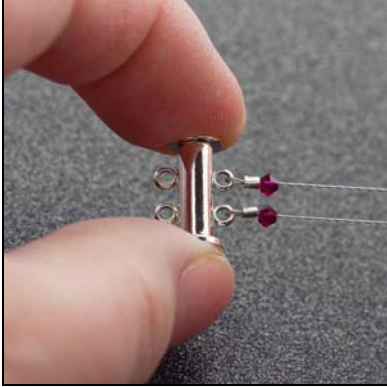
Step 3

Place one crimp bead and the first loop on one side of the tube bar clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters. Crimp a second 10-inch length of beading wire onto the second loop on the clasp, and cover the crimp bead. Trim wire.



Step 4

String one 3mm Ruby crystal bicone bead onto each wire.

**Step 5**

String one Rivoli fancy stone setting onto both strands of wire.

**Step 6**

Repeat Steps 4 – 5 10 times.



Step 7

String one crimp bead and the first loop on the second side of the clasp onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire. Crimp the second beading wire to the second loop, and cover the crimp bead. Trim wire.
