

Blue Waters Necklace by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 19.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 2 - 4mm Caribbean Blue Opal Swarovski Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1315)
- 2 beads - 3mm Teal Fire Polished Round Glass Bead (FP0121)
- 2 beads - 4x5mm Aqua Czech Rondelle Fire Polished Glass Beads (FP3341)
- 2 beads - 7x5mm Blue Zircon Fire Polished Oval Glass Beads (FP2826)
- 1 beads - 14x8mm Green Aqua Teardrop Czech Pressed Glass Bead (GL7830)
- 8 - 2x3.5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Scalloped Bead Caps by TierraCast® (SP2102)
- 4 - 3x5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Leaf Bead Caps by TierraCast® (SP2111)
- 1 - 3x5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Beaded Bead Cap by TierraCast® (SP2112)
- 1 - 7.5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Leaf Bead Cap by TierraCast® (SP2230)
- 32 inches - 3.75mm Silver Plated Brass Pinch Bead Chain (CN6000)
- 2 - 5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 21 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2731)
- 1 - 17mm Sterling Silver Plated Brass 13 gauge Grande Rope Textured Open Jump Ring by Nunn Design (BM3335)
- 9 - 21 gauge Silver Plated Brass 2 inch Head Pins (BM2675)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Simple Loop
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Blue Waters” necklace:

Step 1

Place the following onto one head pin, making one unit:

- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap
- 1 – 7x5mm blue zircon fire polished oval glass bead
- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap

Step 2

Using round nose pliers, turn a loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to the 17mm jump ring.

Step 3

Repeat Steps 1 – 2 with each of the following bead units, attaching each unit to the 17mm jump ring:

- 1 – 4mm Caribbean Blue Opal bicone bead
- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap

- 1 – 3x5mm leaf bead cap
- 1 – 4x5mm aqua rondelle fire polished glass bead
- 1 – 3x5mm leaf bead cap

- 1 – 3mm medium teal fire polished glass round bead
- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap

- 1 – 7.5mm leaf bead cap
- 1 – 14x8mm green aqua teardrop pressed glass bead (wide end first)
- 1 – 3x5mm beaded bead cap

- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap
- 1 – 7x5mm blue zircon fire polished oval glass bead
- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap

- 1 – 4mm Caribbean Blue Opal bicone bead
- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap

- 1 – 3x5mm leaf bead cap
- 1 – 4x5mm aqua rondelle fire polished glass bead
- 1 – 3x5mm leaf bead cap

- 1 – 3mm medium teal fire polished glass round bead
- 1 – 2x3.5mm scalloped bead cap

Step 4

Allow all the bead units to hang down in one direction from the jump ring. Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach one end link of the chain to the 17mm jump ring above the bead units. Close the jump ring.

Step 5

Repeat Step 4 on the opposite end of the chain.
