

Scarab by FusionBeads.com



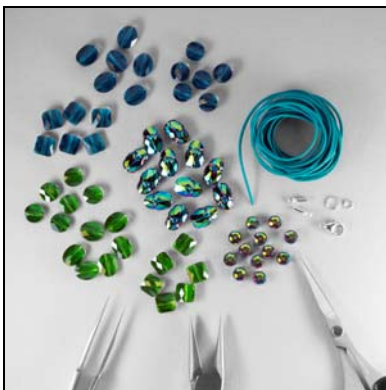
Approximate finished length: 24 inches (triple-wrapped)

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 6 - 6mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green Swarovski Crystal Rondelle Beads (SK2055)
- 3 - 8mm Fern Green Swarovski Crystal Round Mini Beads (SC8573)
- 2 - 8mm Indicolite Swarovski Crystal Round Mini Beads (SC8574)
- 2 - 8mm Fern Green Swarovski Crystal Square Mini Beads (SC8613)
- 3 - 8mm Indicolite Swarovski Crystal Square Mini Beads (SC8614)
- 3 - 10x8mm Fern Green Swarovski Crystal Oval Mini Beads (SC8513)
- 2 - 10x8mm Indicolite Swarovski Crystal Oval Mini Beads (SC8514)
- 7 - 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green Scarab Beads (SK2194)
- 1 - 11.5x6mm Sterling Silver Oval Lobster Claw Clasp (SS4076)
- 2 - Sterling Silver Plain Cylinder Cord Ends with Ring - Fits 1.5mm Round Cord (SS5192)
- 1 - 4mm Sterling Silver 20.5 Gauge Open Jump Ring (SS3916)
- 1 - 6mm Sterling Silver 20.5 Gauge Open Jump Ring (SS3924)
- 2 - 1mm Turquoise Round Leather Cord (SM6121)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Beading Scissors 1-1/4 in. Blade (TL0302)
- Super New Glue (TL2933)
- Chain nose pliers
- Beading Utility Tweezers No 5 (TL1005)



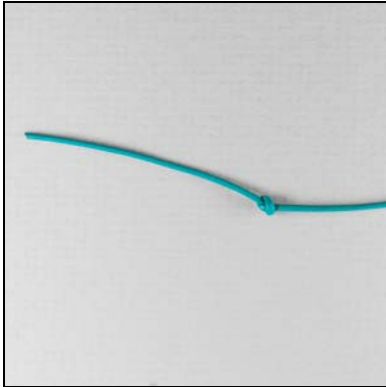
Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Scarab” bracelet:

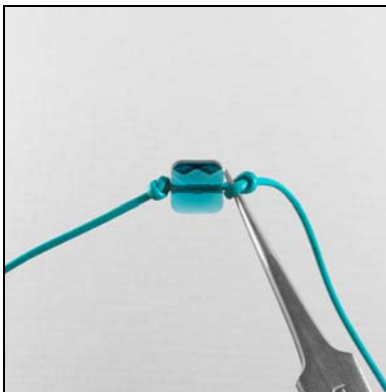
Step 1

Tie an overhand knot in the cord about 1 inch from one end.



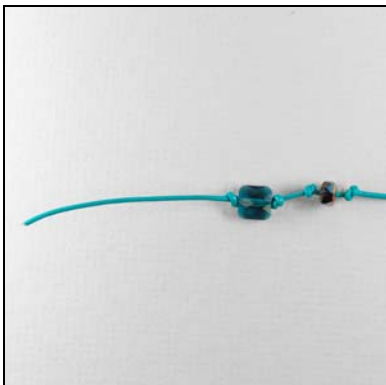
Step 2

String one 8mm Indicolite square mini bead, and slide it up to the knot. Tie a second overhand knot, using tweezers to push the knot close to the bead.



Step 3

Tie an overhand knot about 3/8-inch from the last knot. String one 6mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green rondelle bead. In the same manner as in the previous step, tie an overhand knot close to the bead.



Step 4

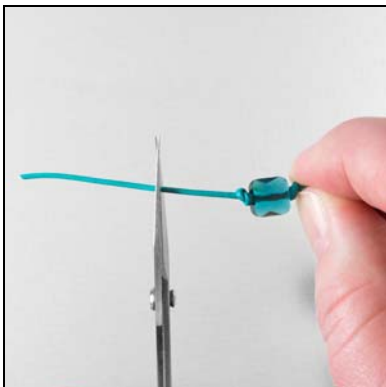
In the same manner as in Step 3, continue tying knots and stringing the remaining beads in the following sequence:

- 1 – 8mm Fern Green round mini bead
- 1 – 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green scarab bead
- 1 – 10x8mm Indicolite oval mini bead
- 1 – 8mm Fern Green square mini bead
- 1 – 6mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green rondelle bead
- 1 – 10x8mm Fern Green oval mini bead
- 1 – 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green scarab bead
- 1 – 10x8mm Indicolite round mini bead
- 1 – 6mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green rondelle bead
- 1 – 8mm Fern Green square mini bead
- 1 – 10x8mm Indicolite oval mini bead
- 1 – 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green scarab bead
- 1 – 6mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green rondelle bead
- 1 – 10x8mm Fern Green oval mini bead
- 1 – 8mm Indicolite square mini bead
- 1 – 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green scarab bead
- 1 – 8mm Fern Green round mini bead
- 1 – 6mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green rondelle bead
- 1 – 8mm Indicolite round mini bead
- 1 – 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green scarab bead
- 1 – 10x8mm Fern Green oval mini bead
- 1 – 6mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green rondelle bead
- 1 – 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green scarab bead
- 1 – 8mm Indicolite square mini bead
- 1 – 8mm Fern Green round mini bead
- 1 – 12mm Crystal Scarabaeus Green scarab bead



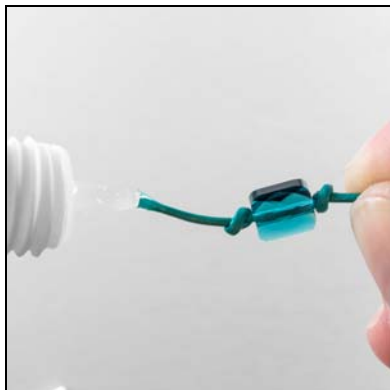
Step 5

Using scissors, trim the cord about 1 inch from the last knot.

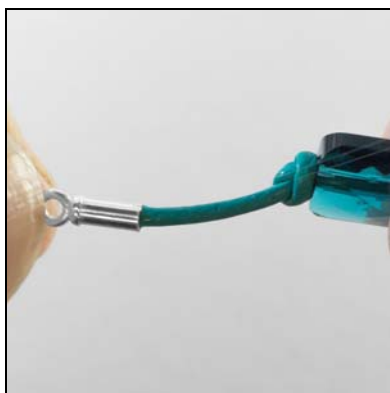


Step 6

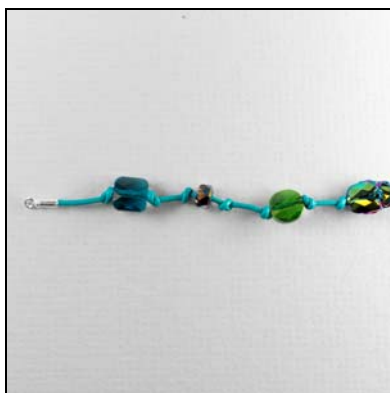
Apply a drop of glue to the end of the cord.

**Step 7**

Attach one cord end to the end of the cord.

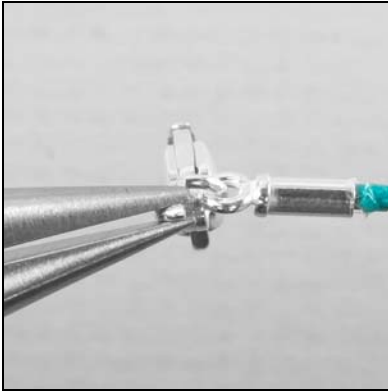
**Step 8**

Repeat Steps 6 – 7 on the other end of the cord with the second cord end.

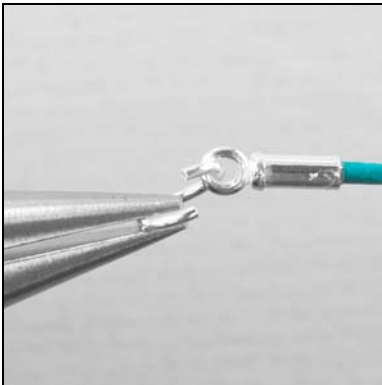


Step 9

Open the 4mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the lobster claw clasp to the loop on one cord end. Close the jump ring.

**Step 10**

Attach the 6mm jump ring to the second cord end.
