

# Lucky Charm by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 1 flat back - 7.1mm Emerald Swarovski Crystal Flat Back Rhinestone - 2088 - SS34 (FT2722)
- 2 - Peridot Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 - 4mm - (04B11116)
- 2 - Emerald Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 - 4mm - (04B11120)
- 2 - Fern Green Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 - 4mm (04B11449)
- 2 - Olivine Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 - 4mm - (04B11117)
- 1 - Pewter Stepped Bezel Charm with Crystal by TierraCast® - Gold - Emerald - 16mm (GP6432)
- 1 - Pewter Celtic Triad Charm by TierraCast® - Antique Gold - 10mm (GP6134)
- 1 - Pewter 4 Leaf Clover Charm by TierraCast® - Antique Gold - 13mm (GP6225)
- 1 - Pewter Celtic Round Charm by TierraCast® - Antique Gold - 15mm (GP6133)
- 1 - Pewter Horseshoe Charm by TierraCast® - Antique Gold - 16mm (GP6285)
- 1 - Brass Wire Bangle Bracelet by TierraCast® - Gold - 7.5 Inch (GP2614)
- 5 - Brass Open Jump Ring by TierraCast® - Gold - 20 gauge - 5.5mm (GP2539)
- 8 - Base Metal Head Pin with 2mm Ball - Gold - 24 gauge - 2 inch (BM2515)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

Chain nose pliers  
Round nose pliers  
Wire cutters  
Hypo tube cement (TL1202)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Wire Wrapping  
Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones into a Rivoli Component

## Instructions to complete “Lucky Charm” bracelet:

### **Step 1**

Apply Hypo Tube Cement to the center of one charm (see Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones into a Rivoli Component Technique). Place one Amethyst crystal Rivoli stone onto the cement, and press firmly. Allow to dry.

### **Step 2**

Place one 4mm Emerald crystal bicone bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Using the tips of the chain nose pliers, grasp the wire directly above the beads (see Wire Wrapping Technique). With your finger, push the wire to a right angle. Using round nose pliers, grasp the wire at the bend. Pull the wire around the jaw until it is pointing almost directly down. Reposition the pliers by opening the jaws (but do not pull them out of the loop), and pivot the pliers so the lower jaw is on top. Continue pulling the wire around the jaw until the loop is completely round. Grip the loop with the chain nose pliers, and grasp the wire with your fingers. Wrap the wire around the head pin. Continue wrapping the wire down to the bead.



### **Step 3**

Using wire cutters, trim excess wire close to the bead. Tuck the remaining tip of wire with chain nose pliers.



#### Step 4

Repeat Step 2-3 with each of the following beads:

- 1 – 4mm Emerald crystal bicone bead
- 2 – 4mm Peridot crystal bicone beads
- 2 – 4mm Fern Green crystal bicone beads
- 2 – 4mm Olivine crystal bicone beads



#### Step 5

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and string the units made in Steps 2 – 4 onto the jump ring, and close the jump ring.



#### Step 6

Repeat Step 5 and attach one jump ring to each of the following charms –

- 4 leaf clover charm
- Celtic triad charm
- Horseshoe charm
- Celtic round charm



### Step 7

String these items in the following sequence onto the bangle bracelet:

- 1 – 4 leaf clover charm
- 1 – Bicone cluster
- 1 – Celtic round charm
- 1 – Horseshoe charm
- 1 – Emerald bezel charm
- 1 – Celtic triad charm
