

# Rose Baroque by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 3 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:**

- 8 - 4mm Crystal Rose Gold Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1476)
- 4 - 10mm Crystal Rose Gold 2X Swarovski Crystal Baroque Bead - 5058 (SK2563)
- 4 - 14mm Crystal Rose Gold 2X Swarovski Crystal Baroque Bead - 5058 (SK2575)
- 2 - Wide Diamond Nimbus Link by Amoracast - Gold Plated Sterling Silver - 39mm (VG0290)
- 1 - Precious Metal French Hoop Ear Wire with 2mm Bead by TierraCast® - Gold-Filled - 21mm (GF2104)
- 8 - Gold-Filled Eye Pin - 22 gauge - 1.5 inch (GF2770)
- 8 - Gold-Filled Head Pin - 22 gauge - 2 inch (GF2767)

## **Tools needed to complete the earrings:**

Chain nose pliers  
Lindstrom Ergonomic Round Nose Pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:**

Attaching an Ear Wire  
Simple Loop



## Instructions to complete “Rose Baroque” earrings:

### **Step 1**

Place one 14mm Rose Gold baroque bead (wide end first) onto one head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin. Cut the head pin, leaving 3/8 inch of wire. Bend the wire at the top of the bead to a right angle with chain nose pliers or your fingers. Grasp the end of the wire with round nose pliers so the wire is flush with the tool. Rotate the pliers to form a loop. Continue turning the wire until a complete loop is formed.



### **Step 2**

Repeat Step 1 with 1 - 14mm baroque bead and 2 – 10mm baroque beads.



### **Step 3**

Place one 4mm Rose Gold crystal bicone bead onto one eye pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the eye pin.



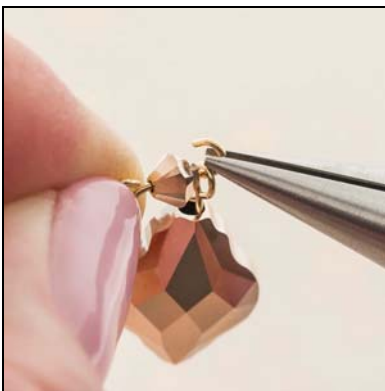
**Step 4**

Repeat Step 3 three times.



**Step 5**

Attach one of the loops just made in the previous step to the loop on one of the baroque beads from Steps 1-2.



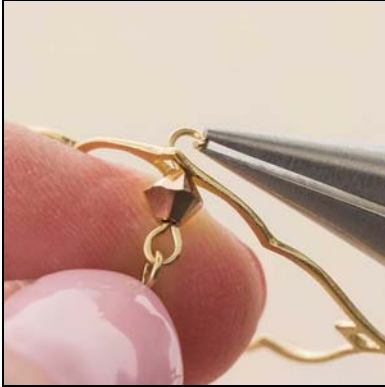
**Step 6**

Repeat Step 5 for the remaining units.



**Step 7**

The wide diamond nimbus link is made up of four points. Attach one of the 10mm Baroque Bead units to one corner of one nimbus link where it is narrowest.

**Step 8**

Attach one of the 14mm Baroque Bead units to one corner of the same nimbus link where it is widest.

**Step 9**

Repeat Steps 7-8 with the same nimbus link and the remaining 10mm and 14mm Baroque Bead units.



**Step 10**

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to the top of the link. Close the loop.

**Step 11**

Repeat Steps 1 – 10 for the second earring.
