

# Pumpkin Party by FusionBeads.com



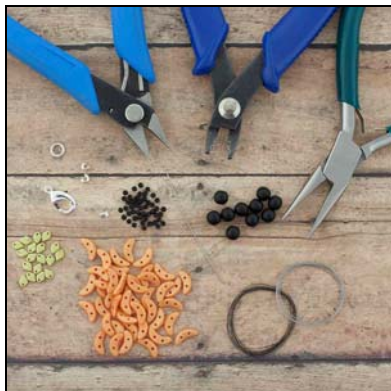
Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 1 gram - Size 11 Matte Opaque Jet Round Japanese Seed Beads by Toho - 49F (SB1574)
- 18 beads - Dragon® Scale Czech Seed Beads - 1.5x5mm - Alabaster Metallic Lime (SB7334)
- 54 beads - CzechMates 2 Hole Crescent Czech Glass Beads - Tangerine Pacifica - 10mm (GL9711)
- 10 - Round Czech Glass Beads - Jet Matte - 6mm (GL1355)
- 1 - Brass Round Closed Jump Ring - Silver - 18 gauge - 6mm (BM5185)
- 2 - Precious Metal Crimp Beads - Sterling Silver - 2x2mm (SS4047)
- 2 - Precious Metal Crimp Bead Covers - Sterling Silver - 3.5mm (SS2103)
- 1 - Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp - Silver - 15mm (BM3154)
- 10 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0310)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

- Crimping pliers (TL0500)
- Wire cutters
- John James English Beading Needles - Size 10 (TL1008)
- Xuron Thread and Fiber Scissors (TL3000)



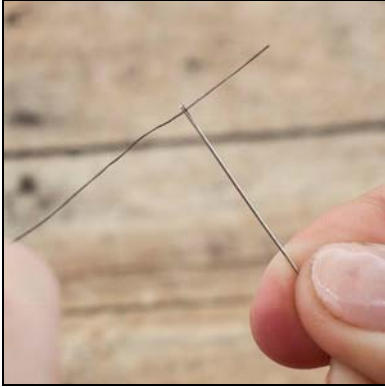
**Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Crimping  
Crimp Bead Covers

**Instructions to complete “Pumpkin Party” bracelet:**

**Step 1**

Thread a needle with a 1-foot length of beading thread.



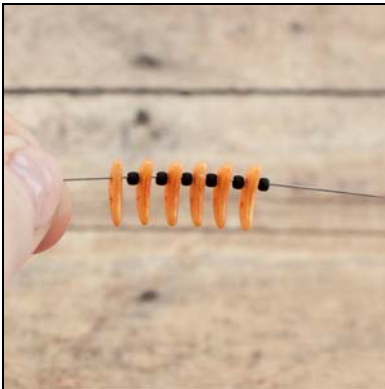
**Step 2**

String the following:

1 hole of 1 tangerine 2-hole crescent bead

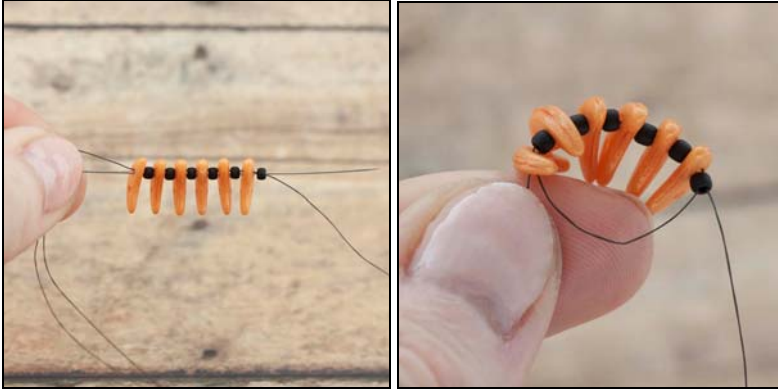
1 – seed bead

Repeat the sequence five times (the crescent beads should all face the same direction).



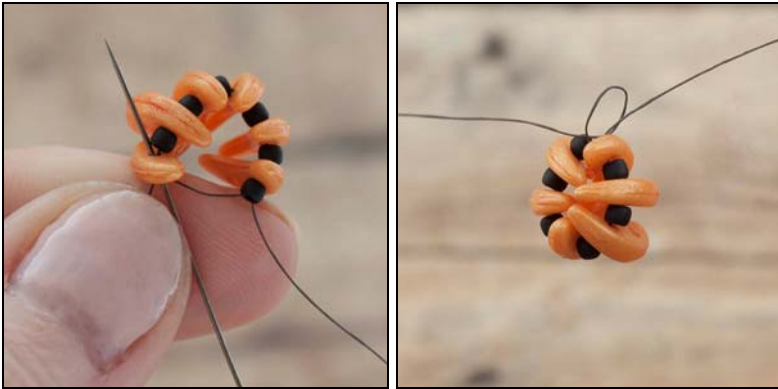
**Step 3**

Pass back through all beads a second time, forming a ring, with the inner curve of all crescent beads facing the center.



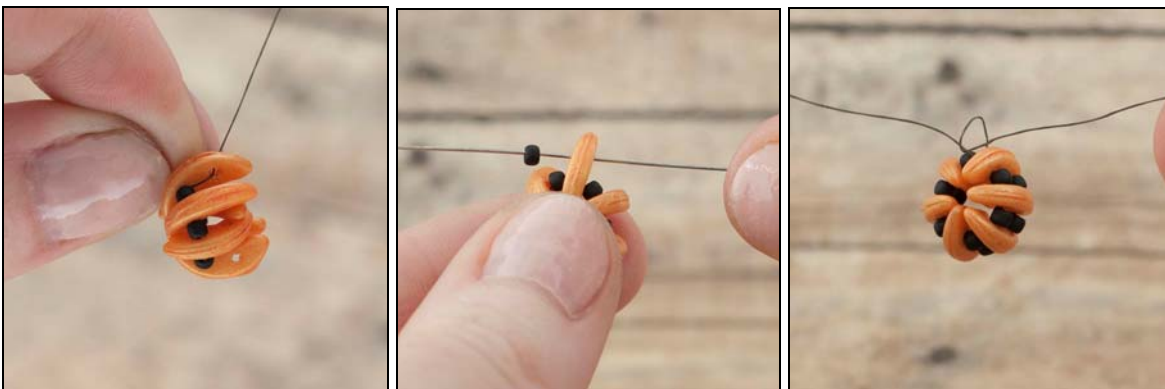
**Step 4**

Go through the first crescent bead from step 2. Tie a double half-hitch knot to secure.



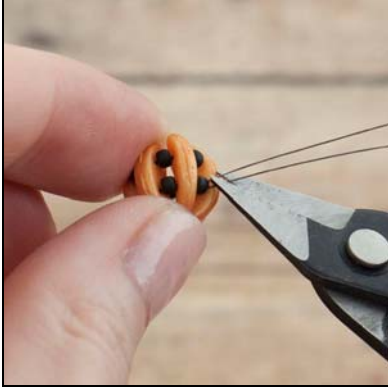
**Step 5**

Go through the second hole of the crescent bead from the previous step. Repeat the stringing sequence of Step 2, this time passing through the second hole of the same crescent beads. Alternate with a seed bead as before. Tie a double half-hitch knot to secure.



**Step 6**

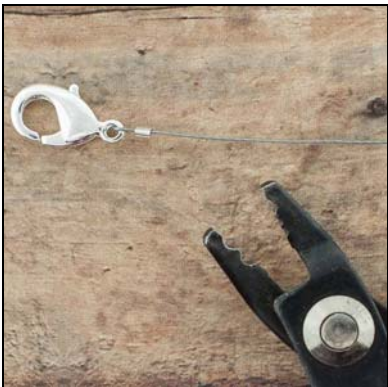
Trim the thread. One beaded bead is complete.

**Step 7**

Repeat Steps 1 – 6 eight times, making a total of nine beaded beads.

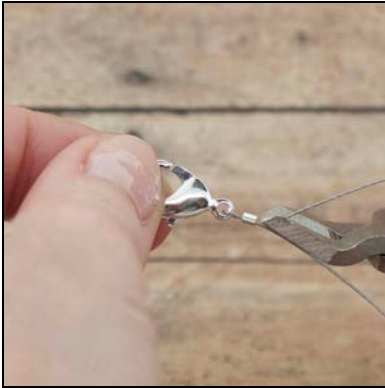
**Step 8**

String one crimp bead and the loop on the lobster claw clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).



**Step 9**

Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

**Step 10**

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).

**Step 11**

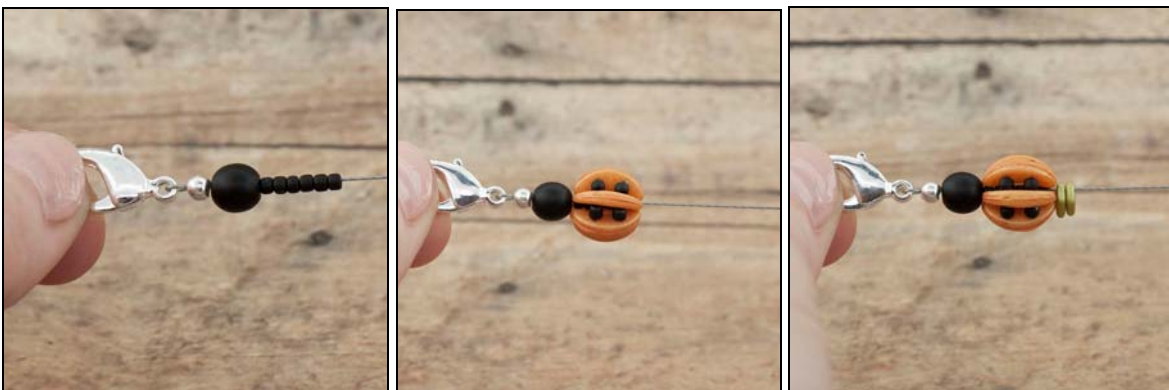
String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

1 – 6mm jet matte round glass bead

6 – jet seed beads

1 – beaded bead (the beaded bead will float over the previous seed beads, concealing them)

2 – alabaster metallic lime Dragon® Scale seed beads



### Step 12

Repeat the sequence eight times, adding one 6mm jet matte round glass bead after the last repeat.



### Step 13

String one crimp bead and the jump ring onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Trim excess wire with wire cutters.



### Step 14

Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover.
