

# Pulling For You by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 42 inches (adjustable)

## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

- 1 - Size 6 Gunmetal Plated Metal Round Seed Bead (SB2985)
- 2 - 30mm Embroidery Thread Tassel with Gold Cap – Black (BM5405)
- 2 - 4mm Gold Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2748)
- 2 - 3x3mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead (GF3129)
- 1 - Base Metal Tube Slide Clasp - Gold - 5.5x7mm (BM5257)
- 2 - Base Metal Plain Glue-In Chain End with Ring - Fits 1.25mm Beading Chain (BM5394)
- 39 inches - Base Metal 1.25mm Beading Chain - Gold (CN7245)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

- Chain Nose Pliers
- Mighty Crimping Pliers (TL0502)
- Wire Cutters
- Super New Glue (TL2933)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

## **Instructions to complete “Pulling For You” necklace:**

### **Step 1**

Cut a 39-inch length of beading chain, have the two ends running parallel and string both ends through the tube slide clasp. Leave a 2 inch tail on both ends of the beading chain.

### **Step 2**

String the following on to one end of the beading chain:

1 - 3x3 crimp bead  
17 - seed beads

### **Step 3**

Connect the glue in end to the chain by dabbing super new glue on a scrap piece of paper. Run the bottom of your chain through the glue and insert it into the chain end. Set aside and let dry for 5 minutes

### **Step 4**

Repeat Step 2-3 for the other end of beading chain.

### **Step 5**

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach one 30mm tassel to the bottom ring of the glue in chain end. Close the jump ring. Repeat for the other end of the beading chain.

### **Step 6**

Using the Mighty Crimping Pliers, crimp the crimp bead in place on the beading wire. Repeat for the other end.
