

Bermuda Nights by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 20 - Pewter Disk Heishi Spacer Bead by TierraCast - Silver - 5mm (SP0310)
- 10 - 6mm Graphite Swarovski Crystal Round Bead - 5000 (06RD0335)
- 12 - 6mm Crystal Silver Night Swarovski Crystal Rondelle Bead - 5040 (SC6776)
- 1 - 30mm Bermuda Blue Swarovski Crystal Fine Rocks Tube Bead - 5950 (SK2945)
- 1 - Pewter Bar and Ring Toggle Clasp by TierraCast - Silver - 16mm (SP2129)
- 2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead (SS4047)
- 2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Cover (SS2103)
- 10 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Crimping Pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Crimping
Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “Bermuda Nights” bracelet:

Step 1

Place one crimp bead and the loop on the ring side of the toggle clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique) and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 2

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

1 – 6mm Crystal Silver Night Swarovski Crystal rondelle bead

1 – 5mm disk heishi

1 – 6mm Graphite Swarovski Crystal round bead

1 – 5mm disk heishi

Repeat the pattern four times then string the following:

1 – 6mm Crystal Silver Night Swarovski Crystal rondelle bead

1 - 30mm Bermuda Blue Swarovski Crystal fine rocks tube bead

*1 – 6mm Crystal Silver Night Swarovski Crystal rondelle bead

1 – 5mm disk heishi

1 – 6mm Graphite Swarovski Crystal round bead

1 – 5mm disk heishi

Repeat the pattern from * four times then string

1 – 6mm Crystal Silver Night Swarovski Crystal rondelle bead

Step 3

Place one crimp bead and the loop on the bar side of the toggle clasp onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 4

Cover the crimp beads with crimp bead covers (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).
