

# Garnet Trio by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.25 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 1 - Brass Tiny Square Spacer Bead - Brass - 2mm - (HH0100)
- 1 - Diamond Cut Faceted Round Gemstone Bead - Garnet - 3mm - (SE5219)
- 3 - Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp - Antique Brass - 12mm - (BM3152)
- 3 - Brass Round Closed Jump Ring - Antique Brass - 18 gauge - 6mm - (BM5187)
- 6 - Base Metal Tube Crimp Bead - Antique Brass - 2x2mm - (BM3367)
- 6 - Base Metal Crimp Bead Cover - Antique Brass - 3mm - (BM3062)
- 30 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool - (SM0310)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

Wire cutters  
Crimping pliers (TL0500)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Crimping  
Crimp Bead Covers

## **Instructions to complete “Garnet Trio” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Place one crimp bead and one lobster clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 2**

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire for the first bracelet:

1 ½ inches – 2mm tiny spacer beads

3 ½ inches – 3mm Garnet beads

1 ½ inches – 2mm tiny spacer beads

### **Step 3**

String one crimp bead and one jump ring onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 4**

Cover the crimp beads with crimp bead covers (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).

### **Step 5**

Repeat Step 1 for the second bracelet.

### **Step 6**

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire for the second bracelet:

3 ¼ inches – 3mm Garnet beads

3 ¼ inches – 2mm tiny spacer beads

### **Step 7**

Repeat Steps 3 and 4 for the second bracelet.

### **Step 8**

Repeat Step 1 for the third bracelet.

### **Step 9**

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire for the third bracelet:

4 inches – 2mm tiny spacer beads

2 ½ inches – 3mm Garnet beads

### **Step 10**

Repeat Steps 3 and 4 for the third bracelet.
