

Golden Mauve by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 21 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 4 - 4mm Crystal Golden Shadow Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 - (04BI1288)
- 18 - 4mm Smoky Mauve Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 - (04BI1488)
- 1 - 8.2mm Crystal Golden Shadow Swarovski Crystal Chaton Stone - 1088 - SS39 - (SC9673)
- 1 - 14mm Smoky Mauve Swarovski Crystal Pear Fancy Stone - 4320 - (SK1467)
- 1 - Pewter Organic Circle Bezel by Nunn Design - Antique Gold - (PE9288)
- 1 - Pewter Organic Pear Bezel by Nunn Design - Antique Gold - (PE9291)
- 1 - Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp - Gold - 15mm - (BM3155)
- 6 - Base Metal 3mm Thin Flat Oval Cable Chain - Gold - (CN4118)
- 1 - 5mm Gold Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring - (BM2760)
- 2 - 6mm Gold Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring - (BM2768)
- 1 - Round Artistic Wire - Gold - 24 gauge - (AW2382)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Round nose pliers (TL0102)
- Chain nose pliers (TL0109)
- Wire cutters (TL2164)
- E6000 Adhesive 0.18 Oz. Tube (TL2921)
- Toothpicks

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Wire Wrapped Link
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Glue Swarovski Elements Rivoli Stones to a Rivoli Component
- Cutting Chain Efficiently

Instructions to complete “Golden Mauve” necklace:

Step 1

Using a toothpick, apply a drop of E6000 adhesive to the inside of the circle bezel.

Step 2

Place the 8.2mm Crystal Golden Shadow Swarovski Crystal Chaton stone onto the adhesive, and press firmly (see Glue Swarovski Elements Rivoli Stones to a Rivoli Component Technique). You can use a toothpick to gently remove any glue that shows through the opening on the back of bezel. Allow to dry. (E6000 takes about 24 hours to fully be dry)

Step 3

Repeat Steps 1-2 using the Pear Bezel and the 14mm Smoky Mauve Swarovski Crystal Pear Fancy Stone.

Step 4

Using wire cutters, cut the cable chain into the following lengths:

1 – 1 ½” or 13-link lengths

2 – ¾” or 6-link lengths

2 – 7 ¾”

2 – 7 ¼”

Step 5

Using a 4-inch length of wire, make a wire wrapped link (see Wire Wrapped Link Technique) with one 4mm Crystal Golden Shadow Swarovski Crystal bicone bead. Connect one side of this wire wrapped link to the end link of the 1 ½” chain and connect the second side of the link to the end link of the ¾” chain.

Step 6

Make a second wire wrapped link with one 4mm Crystal Golden Shadow Swarovski Crystal bicone bead and connect one side of this wire wrapped link to the other end link of the ¾” chain from Step 5 and then connect the second side of the link to the end link of the 7 ¾” chain.

Step 7

Repeat Steps 5-6 with the two remaining 4mm Crystal Golden Shadow Swarovski Crystal bicone beads.

Step 8

Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the circle bezel to the center of the 1 ½” link of chain from Step 5. Close the jump ring.

Step 9

Using a 4-inch length of wire, make a wire wrapped link with one 4mm Smoky Mauve Swarovski Crystal bicone bead. Connect one side of this wire wrapped link to the loop on the pear bezel from Step 3.

Step 10

Make a second wire wrapped link with one 4mm Smoky Mauve Swarovski Crystal bicone bead and connect it to the first wire wrapped link from Step 9.

Step 11

Repeat Step 10 seven more times for a total of nine wire wrapped links on one side of the necklace. Attaching the last wire wrapped link to the end link of 7 ¼” chain.

Step 12

Repeat Steps 9-11 for the other side of the necklace, connecting it to the second length of 7 ¼” chain.

Step 13

Open one 6mm jump ring and use the jump ring to attach one end link from short necklace, one end link from the long necklace and the lobster clasp. Close the jump ring.

Step 14

Open another 6mm jump ring and use the jump ring to attach one end link from short necklace, one end link from the long necklace. Close the jump ring.
