

Silver Eila Swirl Earrings by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 2.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 2 - 14x10mm Royal Blue Shiny Swarovski Crystal Pear Fancy Stone - 4320 (SK2389)
- 2 - Pewter Organic Pear Bezel by Nunn Design - Antique Silver (PE9292)
- 2 - Pewter Spiral Swirl Link by Nunn Design - Antique Silver - 33mm (BM1141)
- 1 - 4mm Sterling Silver Ball Post Earring with Ring (SS2608)
- 1 - 4mm Sterling Silver Clutch Earring Back (SS2611)
- 2 - 5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 18 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2832)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

Chain nose pliers
E6000 Adhesive 0.18 Oz. Tube (TL2921)
Toothpicks

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Attaching an Ear Wire
Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones Into a Rivoli Component

Instructions to complete “Silver Eila Swirl” earrings:

Step 1

Using a toothpick, apply a drop of E6000 adhesive to the inside of the pear bezel.

Step 2

Place the 14x10mm Royal Blue Shiny Swarovski Crystal Pear Fancy Stone onto the adhesive, and press firmly (see Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones Into a Rivoli Component Technique). You can use a toothpick to gently remove any glue that shows through the opening on the back of bezel. Allow to dry. (E6000 takes about 24 hours to fully be dry)

Step 3

Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Attach the jump ring to the crystal charm and one loop of the link. Close the jump ring.

Step 4

Open the loop on one ear post (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique) and attach it to the other loop on the link in Step 3. Close the loop.

Step 5

Repeat Steps 1 – 4 for the second earring. Note: Make sure that the links are facing opposite of each other.
