Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 26 - 4mm Crystal Aurum 2X Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1520)
- 6 - 4mm Erinite AB 2X Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1525)
- 6 - 4mm Chrysolite Opal AB 2X Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1518)
- 6 - 4mm Light Turquoise AB 2X Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1528)
- 1 - 13mm Gold-Filled Oval Lobster Clasp (GF2805)
- 1 - 6mm Gold-Filled 22 Gauge Closed Jump Ring (GF2670)
- 2 - 2x2mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead (GF2788)
- 2 - 3.5mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead Cover (GF2101)
- 10 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - 24k Gold Extreme - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0322)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Crimping Pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Crimping
Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “A Touch of Class” bracelet:

Step 1

Place one crimp bead and one lobster clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 2

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

- 11 – Crystal Aurum 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone beads
- 3 – Chrysolite Opal AB 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone beads
- 1 – Crystal Aurum 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone bead
- 3 – Light Turquoise AB 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone beads
- 1 – Crystal Aurum 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone bead
- 6 – Erinite AB 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone beads
- 1 – Crystal Aurum 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone bead
- 3 – Light Turquoise AB 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone beads
- 1 – Crystal Aurum 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone bead
- 3 – Chrysolite Opal AB 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone beads
- 11 – Crystal Aurum 2X Swarovski Crystal bicone beads

Step 3

String one crimp bead and one jump ring onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 4

Cover the crimp beads with crimp bead covers (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).
