- 1 - Size 6 Red Metal Round Seed Bead (SB7760)
- 1 - Size 6 Orange Metal Round Seed Bead (SB7759)
- 1 - Size 6 Dark Blue Metal Round Seed Bead (SB7765)
- 1 - Pewter Dagger Charm by TierraCast - 13mm - Rhodium (SP6558)
- 1 - Pewter Mini Naja Charm by TierraCast - 13mm - Antique Brass (AP6222)
- 1 - Pewter Mini North Star Charm by TierraCast - 14mm - Antique Silver (SP6618)
- 1 - Pewter Mini Hamsa Hand Charm by TierraCast - 12mm - Antique Gold (GP6588)
- 1 - Pewter Mini Arrow Charm by TierraCast - 19mm - Antique Brass (AP6225)
- 2 - Pewter Barrel Large Hole Bead by TierraCast - Antique Pewter - 10mm (QP0107)
- 1 - Pewter Ethnic Spike Charm by TierraCast - 17mm - Antique Gold (GP6525)
- 1 - 30mm Embroidery Thread Tassel with Silver Cap - Navy Blue (BM5401)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

Chain Nose Pliers
Round Nose Pliers

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Around the World” necklace:

Step 1

Unhook the component and using your chain nose pliers, gently bend the hooked end to straighten it out so you can slide on the beads and charms.

Step 2

Open one 4mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), string on the mini Hamsa charm and one 4mm jump ring, and close the jump ring.

Step 3

Repeat Step 2 with the following charms –
mini north star charm
mini arrow charm
30mm navy blue tassel
mini naja charm
13mm dagger charm

Step 4

Open one 5mm jump ring and attach it to the 17mm ethnic spike charm, and close the jump ring.

Step 5

String these beads in the following sequence onto one component:

1 – orange metal seed bead
1 – dark blue metal seed bead
1 – mini Hamsa charm
1 – red metal seed bead
1 – orange metal seed bead
1 – mini north star charm
1 – dark blue metal seed bead
1 – red metal seed bead
1 – mini arrow charm
1 – orange metal seed bead
1 – dark blue metal seed bead
1 – 30mm navy blue tassel
1 – red metal seed bead
1 – orange metal seed bead
1 – 17mm ethnic spike charm
1 – red metal seed bead
1 – dark blue metal seed bead
1 – mini naja charm
1 – dark blue metal seed bead
1 – orange metal seed bead
1 – 13mm dagger charm
1 – red metal seed bead
1 – orange metal seed bead

Step 6

Using round nose pliers, gently turn the end of the wire component to recreate the hook to close the component.

Step 7

Thread the 36 inch piece of deer lace through the loop on the component and bring the component to the center of the deer lace. Bring the two ends of the deer lace together (smooth sides facing out) and thread the ends through one barrel bead. Bring the barrel bead all the way down to the component.

Step 8

Bring the two ends of the deer lace together (smooth sides facing out) and thread the ends through a second barrel bead. This will act as the closure to the necklace and can be adjustable to multiple lengths. Tie an overhand knot at the end of both piece of deer lace.
