

Beckoning Kitty by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches, adjustable

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 13 - Pewter Disk Heishi Spacer Bead by TierraCast - Gold - 5mm (GP0307)
- 20 beads - Verdite Round Gemstone Bead - 8mm (SE5268)
- 1 - Pewter Beckoning Kitty Charm by TierraCast - 16mm - Antique Gold (GP6602)
- 1 - 17mm Embroidery Thread Tassel with Gold Cap - Black (BM5425)
- 1 - 5.5mm Gold Plated Brass 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring by TierraCast (GP2539)
- 1 - 2x2mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead (GF2788)
- 1 - 4mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead Cover (GF2792)
- 10 inches - Stretch Magic Elastic Cord - Clear - 0.8mm diameter - 5 Meter Spool (SM6285)

Tools needed to complete one bracelet:

- Chain Nose Pliers
- Xuron Thread and Fiber Scissors
- Crimping Pliers

Beading Techniques needed to complete one bracelet:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Crimping Stretch Magic
- Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “Beckoning Kitty” bracelet:

Step 1

Open one jump ring and attach it to the loop of the tassel charm (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Close the jump ring.

Step 2

String the following beads onto a 10-inch length of stretch cord:

- 1 – metal bead
- 1 - beckoning kitty charm
- 1 – metal bead
- 5 – gemstone beads
- 3 – metal beads
- 5 – gemstone beads
- 3 – metal beads
- 5 – gemstone beads
- 3 – metal beads
- 5 – gemstone beads
- 1 – metal bead
- 1 – jump ring on the tassel charm
- 1 – metal bead
- 1 – crimp bead

Step 3

Slide the opposite end of the cord through the crimp bead so that the ends of the cord are facing in opposite directions. (see Crimping Stretch Magic Technique). Crimp the crimp bead with chain nose pliers. Trim the cord with scissors. Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).
