Approximate finished length: 34 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 14 - 4mm Light Sapphire Swarovski Crystal Round Bead - 5000 (04RD0120)
- 16 - 5mm Sapphire Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (05BI1156)
- 16 - 6mm Dark Indigo Swarovski Crystal Round Bead - 5000 (06RD0286)
- 10 - Pewter Organic Small Metal Bead by Nunn Design - 5-8mm - Antique Silver (PE9469)
- 1 - Pewter Sea Snail Charm by Nunn Design - 11mm - Antique Silver (PE9457)
- 1 - Pewter Turret Shell Charm by Nunn Design - 17mm - Antique Silver (PE9459)
- 1 - Pewter Narwhal Charm by Nunn Design - 29mm - Antique Silver (PE9462)
- 1 - Pewter Small Starfish Charm by Nunn Design - Antique Silver - 20mm (PE3480)
- 1 - Pewter Trumpet Shell Charm by Nunn Design - Antique Silver - 21mm (PE9176)
- 1 - Pewter Seahorse Charm by Nunn Design - Antique Silver - 23mm (PE3388)
- 1 - Pewter Scallop Shell Charm by Nunn Design - 31mm - Antique Silver (PE9464)

- 8 - 9mm Antique Silver Plated Brass 16 gauge Textured Open Jump Ring by Nunn Design (BM3330)
- 2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead (SS4047)
- 2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Cover (SS2103)
- 12 inches - Round Leather Cord - Royal Blue - 1mm (SM6143)
- 14 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters
Crimping pliers

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

Crimping
Crimp Bead Covers
Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Lark's Head Knot

Instructions to complete “Ocean Shore” necklace:

Step 1

Using wire cutters cut the following lengths of chain –

1 – 5 links long

1 – 6 links long

1 – 9 links long

1- 24 inches



Refer the image above for the order to add the charms and leather.

Step 2

Open one 9mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and use the jump ring to attach the starfish charm to the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring.

Step 3

Open one 9mm jump ring and attach the jump ring to the end of the 6 link length of chain and the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring. Open a 5mm jump ring and use the jump to attach the narwhal charm to the end of the chain. Close the jump ring.

Step 4

Open one 9mm jump ring and attach the jump ring to the end of the 5 link length of chain and the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring. Open a 5mm jump ring and use the jump to attach the trumpet shell charm to the end of the chain. Close the jump ring.

Step 5

Using wire cutters cut one 12-inch length of leather. Fold the leather in half and thread the fold through the hammered circle pendant, and tie a Lark's head knot (see Lark's Head Knot Technique). Randomly add three organic small metal beads to each leather strand, tying an overhand knot after each metal bead. Trim the end of the leather after the last knot.

Step 6

Open one 9mm jump ring and use the jump ring to attach the scallop shell charm to the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring.

Step 7

Open one 9mm jump ring and use the jump ring to attach the seahorse charm to the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring.

Step 8

Open one 9mm jump ring and attach the jump ring to the end of the 9 link length of chain and the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring. Open a 5mm jump ring and use the jump to attach the sea snail charm to the end of the chain. Close the jump ring.

Step 9

Open one 9mm jump ring and use the jump ring to attach the turret shell charm to the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring.

Step 10

Open one 9mm jump ring and attach the jump ring to the loop on the hammered circle pendant. Close the jump ring and set aside.

Step 11

Place one crimp bead and the end of the 24-inch length of chain onto a 14-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 12

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

- 7 – 4mm light Sapphire crystal rounds
- 1 - organic small metal bead
- 8 - 5mm Sapphire crystal bicones
- 1 - organic small metal bead
- 8 – 6mm dark Indigo crystal rounds
- jump ring on the hammered circle pendant
- 8 – 6mm dark Indigo crystal rounds
- 1 - organic small metal bead
- 8 - 5mm Sapphire crystal bicones
- 1 - organic small metal bead
- 7 – 4mm light Sapphire crystal rounds

Step 13

String one crimp bead and the other end of the 24-inch length of chain. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 14

Cover the crimp beads with crimp bead covers (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).
