

Tourmaline by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

22 - 4mm Sterling Silver Beaded Daisy Heishi Spacer Beads (SS5160)
21 beads - 6mm Multi Tourmaline Round Gemstone Beads (SE5401)
1 - 11.5mm Thai Hill Tribe Silver Elephant Charm (TH6907)
1 - 11mm Sterling Silver Toggle Clasp With Ball Ends (SS4753)
1 - 4mm Sterling Silver 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (SS4934)
2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead (SS4047)
2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Cover (SS2103)
10 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Chain nose Pliers
Wire cutters
Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Crimping
Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “Tourmaline” bracelet:

Step 1

Place one crimp bead and the loop on the ring side of the toggle clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 2

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 3

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

1 – 4mm beaded daisy heishi spacer bead

1 – 6mm multi Tourmaline round gemstone beads

Repeat the sequence 20 times, then string the following:

1 – 4mm beaded daisy heishi spacer bead

Step 4

String one crimp bead and the loop on the bar side of the toggle clasp onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead.

Step 5

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 6

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and attach it to the loop on the Elephant charm and the loop on the ring side of the toggle clasp, and close the jump ring.
