

Full Bloom by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 20 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 44 - 3mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Faceted Spacer By TierraCast (SP0188)
- 12 beads - Fuchsia Fire Polished Round Glass Bead - 4mm (FP0362)
- 22 beads - Milky Pink Fire Polished Round Glass Bead - 4mm (FP0315)
- 12 beads - Purple and Pink Mix Czech Rondelle Fire Polished Glass Bead - 5x3mm (GL5632)
- 12 beads - Milky Pink Fire Polished Glass Round Bead - 8mm (FP2076)
- 10 beads - Hibiscus Flower Czech Glass Bead - Purple Opaline with Picasso - 12mm (GL6066)
- 1 - 58mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Blossom Pendant by TierraCast (SP6660)
- 1 - Pewter Floral Toggle Clasp by TierraCast - Antique Silver - 20mm (SP2512)
- 1 - 5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Meandering Spacer Bail by TierraCast (SP6662)
- 1 - 5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2759)
- 2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead (SS4047)
- 2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Cover (SS2103)
- 24 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Full Bloom” necklace:

Step 1

Open the jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Attach the jump ring to the pendant and to the loop on the bail. Close the jump ring.

Step 2

Place one crimp bead and the loop on the ring side of the toggle clasp onto a 24-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 3

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

- 1 – 4mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 4mm fuchsia Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 8mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 5x3mm purple and pink mix rondelle Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 4mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 12mm purple opaline with picasso Hibiscus flower glass bead

Repeat the above sequence four times. Then string:

- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 4mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 4mm fuchsia Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 8mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 5x3mm purple and pink mix rondelle Fire Polished glass bead
- Bail with the pendant
- 1 – 5x3mm purple and pink mix rondelle Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- *1 – 8mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 4mm fuchsia Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 4mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 12mm purple opaline with picasso Hibiscus flower glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 4mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 5x3mm purple and pink mix rondelle Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead

Repeat the sequence from * four times. Then string:

- 1 – 8mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 3mm faceted spacer bead
- 1 – 4mm fuchsia Fire Polished glass bead
- 1 – 4mm milky pink Fire Polished glass bead

Step 4

String one crimp bead and the loop on the toggle bar side of the clasp onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 5

Cover the crimp beads with crimp bead covers (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).
