Approximate finished length: 2.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 54 - 3mm Erinite Shimmer 2X Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead – 5328 (03BI1471)
- 2 - 18mm Laguna DeLite Swarovski Crystal Pear Fancy Stone – 4320 (SK3220)
- 2 - 18x13mm Rhodium Glue-In Charm Setting For #4320 Swarovski Crystal Pear Fancy Stone (BM5532)
- 2 - 28mm Sterling Silver Flat Wire Circle Component (SS4296)
- 2 - 6mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2767)
- 1 - 22mm Sterling Silver French Hoop Ear Wire with 2mm Bead by TierraCast (SS2607)
- 4 feet - Round Artistic Wire - Tarnish Resistant Silver - 26 gauge (AW2157)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- E6000 (TL2921)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Attaching an Ear Wire
- Covering a Component – Surface
- Glue Swarovski Elements Rivoli Stones to a Rivoli Component

Instructions to complete “Laguna Beach” earrings:

Step 1

Apply a drop of E6000 adhesive to the center of one glue-in setting (see Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones into a Rivoli Component Technique). Place one crystal fancy stone onto the adhesive, and press firmly. Allow to dry

Step 2

Anchor a 2 foot length of wire to one component (see Covering a Component – Surface Technique). Cover the component with 27 - 3mm Erinite Shimmer 2X bicone beads. Anchor the wire and trim.

Step 3

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the component to the top loop of the glue-in setting. Close the jump ring.

Step 4

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to the top of the component between the first and last beads added.

Step 5

Repeat Steps 1 – 4 for the second earring.
