

# My Little Ones by FusionBeads.com

## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

- 1 - 4mm Emerald Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1120)
- 1 - 4mm Aquamarine Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1123)
- 1 - 4mm Tangerine Swarovski Crystal Bicone Bead - 5328 (04BI1481)
- 1 - 28mm Sterling Silver Flat Wire Circle Component (SS4296)
- 18 inches - 2mm Sterling Silver Flat Cable Chain | Fusion Beads (CN0270)
- 1 - 11mm Sterling Silver Oval Lobster Claw Clasp (SS4076)
- 4 - 5mm Sterling Silver 19 Gauge Open Jump Ring (SS3948)
- 6 inches - Round Sterling Silver Half Hard Wire - 26 gauge - 5 feet (SW0118)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

Filling a Component  
Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

## **Instructions to complete “My Little Ones” necklace:**

### **Step 1**

Anchor a 6-inch length of wire around the component by wrapping the wire three times (see Filling a Component Technique).

### **Step 2**

String these beads in the following sequence onto the wire:

1 – 4mm Aquamarine bicone bead

1 – 4mm Emerald bicone bead

1 – 4mm Tangerine bicone bead

Anchor the wire onto the opposite side of the component by bring the wire behind the component and then up over the top of the component wrapping it three times. Trim the wire.

### **Step 3**

Using wire cutters, cut the chain in half so you have two 9-inch lengths of chain.

### **Step 4**

Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Attach the jump ring to the component so the jump ring is between the two anchored wire ends and to one end of one of the 9-inch lengths of chain. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 5**

Repeat Step 4 for the second 9-inch length of chain.

### **Step 6**

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to attach the loop on the lobster claw clasp to the unattached end of one of the chains. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 5**

Open one 5mm jump ring, and attach it to the other unattached end of one of the chain. Close the jump ring.
