

Wanderlust Cuff Bracelet by Lindsay Burke of FusionBeads.com

Whether you're headed to the Grand Caymans or just to the grocery store, the Wanderlust Cuff Bracelet is the only accessory you'll need! At once trendy and traditional, this wear-anywhere metal cuff features a seed bead centerpiece that was inspired by the rich textiles of your travels. To make the bracelet, you'll start with a Centerline cuff—it was designed with holes to accommodate beadwork. With double needles and thread, you'll attach Delica seed beads, creating unique patterns that you can personalize to your tastes.

Approximate finished length: 5.5 inch adjustable

Beads and other products needed for bracelet:

- 1 gram - Size 11 Matte Eggshell Delica Beads - DB0352 ([11DB0352](#)) (A)
- 1 gram - Size 11 Matte Black Delica Beads - DB0310 ([11DB0310](#)) (B)
- 1 gram - Size 11 Silver Lined Lemon Tart Duracoat Delica Beads - DB2186 ([11DB2186](#)) (C)
- 1 gram - Size 11 Vermilion Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2108 ([11DB2108](#)) (D)
- 1 gram - Size 11 Light Maroon Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2119 ([11DB2119](#)) (E)
- 1 gram - Size 11 Tiffany Blue Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2133 ([11DB2133](#)) (F)
- 1 - Superlon Beading Thread - Black, Size D ([SM4302](#))
- 1 - Gold Plated Centerline Cuff - 5.5 inch ([BM5484](#))

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

- Tulip Beading Needles - Size 11 ([TL2648](#))
- Xuron Thread and Fiber Scissors ([TL3000](#))
- Hypo Tube Cement ([TL1202](#))

Instructions to complete "Wanderlust Cuff" bracelet:

Step 1

Thread a needle onto each end of a 3 foot length of thread.

Step 2

Starting at one end of the cuff bracelet, use one needle to go down through first hole on the left side of the opening.

Step 3

String the following beads onto the right needle:

1 - Size 11 Tiffany Blue Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2133 ([11DB2133](#)) (F)

1 - Size 11 Matte Black Delica Beads - DB0310 ([11DB0310](#)) (B)

1 - Size 11 Matte Eggshell Delica Beads - DB0352 ([11DB0352](#)) (A)

Then go down through the first set of holes on the right side of the opening.

Step 4

Step up to the next hole on both sides of the cuff opening and bring your needles up through the second set of holes.

Step 5

String the following beads onto the right needle:

2 - Size 11 Tiffany Blue Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2133 ([11DB2133](#)) (F)

1 - Size 11 Matte Black Delica Beads - DB0310 ([11DB0310](#)) (B)

Go through these beads again using the left needle. (**Note:** You will pass through each set of beads with each needle. The needles will continue switching sides for each row.)

Step 6

Go down through the set of holes you came up in step 4 on both sides of the opening.

Step 7

Step up to the next hole on both sides of the cuff opening and bring your needles up through the next set of holes.

Step 8

Repeat steps 5-7 following the following bead pattern for each of the rows. You should have a total of 22 rows of beads.

Row 3 – F, B, A

Row 4 – B, A, C

Row 5 – A, C, D

Row 6 – C, D, E

Row 7 – D, E, E

Row 8 – C, D, E

Row 9 – A, C, D

Row 10 – B, A, C

Row 11 – F, B, A

Row 12 – F, F, B

Row 13 – F, B, A

Row 14 – B, A, C

Row 15 – A, C, D

Row 16 – C, D, E

Row 17 – D, E, E

Row 18 – C, D, E

Row 19 – A, C, D

Row 20 – B, A, C

Row 21 – F, B, A

Row 22 – F, F, B

Step 9

String the following beads for row 23 – F, B, A, E. Go down through the set of holes you came up in this step.

Step 10

Using the two threads, tie a surgeon's knot. Cut the thread close.

(Note: You can add a drop of Hypo Tube Cement on the knot for added security)

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
