

Strength Morse Code by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 18 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 12 - 3mm Sterling Silver Round Bead (SS0520)
- 6 - 3x2mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead (GF2789)
- 1 - 9mm Sterling Silver Oval Lobster Claw Clasp (SS4075)
- 2 - 5mm Sterling Silver 19 Gauge Open Jump Ring (SS3948)
- 2 - Sterling Silver Cord End - Fits 0.8mm Beading Wire (SS4762)
- 18 inches - 0.8mm Sterling Silver Beading Chain (CN0145)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Chain Nose Pliers
- Wire Cutters
- Super New Glue (TL2933)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Strength Morse Code” necklace:

Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut your beading chain into one 18-inch piece.

Step 2

String the following beads to spell out the word “strength” in Morse Code onto the beading chain:

S

3 – silver round beads

T

1 – gold crimp bead

R

1 – silver round bead

1 – gold crimp bead

1 – silver round bead

E

1 – silver round bead

N

1 – gold crimp bead

1 – silver round bead

G

2 – gold crimp beads

1 – silver round bead

T

1 – gold crimp bead

H

4 – silver round beads

Step 3

Connect the glue in end to the chain by dabbing super new glue on a scrap piece of paper. Run the bottom of your chain through the glue and insert it into the chain end. Set aside and let dry for at least 5 minutes before handling it.

Step 4

Repeat Step 3 for the other end of beading chain.

Step 5

Open one 5mm jump ring. Attach the loop on the lobster claw and the loop at the end of one of the chain ends (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring). Close the jump ring.

Step 6

Open one 5mm jump ring. Attach the loop at the end of the other cord end. Close the jump ring.
