

I Love You Morse Code by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 8 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- .5 grams - Size 8 Metallic Silver Round Japanese Seed Bead (SB0950)
- 1 gram - Size 8 Duracoat Opaque Dyed Dark Salmon Pink Round Japanese Seed Beads by Miyuki - 4464 (SB7490)
- .5 grams - Size 8 White Lined Transparent Cobalt Round Japanese Seed Bead (SB1051)
- .6 grams - Size 8 Opaque Turquoise Round Japanese Seed Beads by Toho - 55 (SB0842)
- 1 - Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp - Silver - 12mm (BM3150)
- 1 - 4mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2747)
- 1 - 5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2759)
- 2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead (SS4047)
- 2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Cover (SS2103)
- 10 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “I Love You Morse Code” bracelet:

Step 1

We made this bracelet using the International Morse Code Chart listed on the last page of these instructions.

Step 2

Open a 4mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and attach it to the loop on the lobster claw clasp. Close the jump ring.

Step 3

Place one crimp bead and the 4mm jump ring with the lobster claw clasp from Step 2 onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 4

We made this bracelet using the International Morse Code Chart listed on the last page of these instructions. We used the size 8 Opaque Turquoise round Japanese seed beads to represent the dots. One seed bead per dot. We used the size 8 White Lined Transparent Cobalt round Japanese seed beads to represent the dashes. Two seed beads per dash. The size 8 Metallic Silver round Japanese seed beads are used in between each “letter”. The size 8 Duracoat Opaque Dyed Dark Salmon Pink round Japanese seed beads are used to fill in the bracelet.

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire strand to spell “I love you” in Morse Code:

21 - Size 8 Duracoat Opaque Dyed Dark Salmon Pink round Japanese seed beads

1 - Size 8 Metallic Silver round Japanese seed bead

2 - Size 8 Opaque Turquoise round Japanese seed beads

1 - Size 8 Opaque Turquoise round Japanese seed bead

2 - Size 8 White Lined Transparent Cobalt round Japanese seed beads

6 - Size 8 White Lined Transparent Cobalt round Japanese seed beads

21 - Size 8 Duracoat Opaque Dyed Dark Salmon Pink round Japanese seed beads

Step 5

Place one crimp bead and one 5mm jump ring onto the end of the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 6

Cover the crimp beads with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).
