

# Jasper Mountain by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

21 beads - Size 8 Nickel Plated Glass Round Japanese Seed Beads by Toho – 711 (SB1230)  
22 beads - 6mm Ocean Jasper Round Gemstone Bead (SE5405)  
5 - 5mm Antique Silver Plated Brass 18 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM0423)  
2 - 8mm Antique Silver Plated Brass 18 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM0425)  
2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead (SS4047)  
2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Cover (SS2103)  
2 - 8mm Sterling Silver Ribbon End (SS4415)  
1 - 17mm Antique Silver Plated Brass Swivel Lobster Clasp (BM4038)  
6 inches - 3.75mm Antique Silver Plated Base Metal Pinch Bead Chain (CN6005)  
10 inches - Soft Flex Beading Wire - Clear - .014" diameter - 10 foot spool (SM0310)  
6 inches - 5mm Saddle Deertan Lace (SM5157)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

Chain Nose Pliers  
Crimping Pliers  
Wire Cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Crimping  
Crimp Bead Covers  
Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

## **Instructions to complete “Jasper Mountain” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Using wire cutters, cut 1–10 inch lengths of beading wire.

### **Step 2**

Place one crimp bead on one 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire through one 8mm jump ring, back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 3**

String the following:

1 - 6mm gemstone bead

1 – size 8 seed bead

Repeat the above sequence 20 times and then string one 6mm gemstone bead.

### **Step 4**

Repeat Step 2 to attach the other end of the beading wire to the other 8mm jump ring.

### **Step 5**

Cover the crimp beads with crimp bead covers (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique).

### **Step 6**

Cut a 6-inch length of chain.

### **Step 7**

Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Attach the last link on the chain to the 5mm jump ring. Attach the 5mm jump ring to the 8mm jump ring from Step 2. Close the 5mm jump ring.

### **Step 8**

Repeat Step 7 to attach the other end of the chain to the other 8mm jump ring from Step 4.

### **Step 9**

Cut a 6-inch length of deertan lace. Insert one end of the cord into the ribbon end. With the chain nose pliers, grasp the middle of the ribbon end and gently squeeze the ribbon end against the cord. Continue to squeeze the ribbon end in the corners and all around until it is flattened and the deertan lace is secure. Optional: You can also dab a bit of glue before inserting the cord into your ribbon end.

### **Step 10**

Open one 5mm jump ring. Attach the loop of the ribbon end to the 5mm jump ring. Attach the 5mm jump ring to the 8mm jump ring from Step 2. Close the 5mm jump ring.

### **Step 11**

Repeat Steps 9-10 to attach the other ribbon end to the other 8mm jump ring from Step 4.

### **Step 12**

Open one 5mm jump ring and attach the lobster clasp to the end 8mm jump ring from Step 2. Close the jump ring.
