

# Jewel Point it Out by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 22 inches (double-wrapped)

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

140 beads - 2x4mm Opaque Turquoise Bronze Picasso MiniDuo 2 Hole Seed Beads (SB7042) (C)

28 beads - 2x5mm Lilac Pastel SuperDuo 2 Hole Seed Bead (SB6495) (B)

42 beads - 2x5mm Denim Blue Polychrome SuperDuo 2 Hole Seed Bead (SB7636) (A)

1 - Jardin 2 Hole Button by TierraCast - 17mm - Antique Brass (AP6213)

48 inches - 1.5mm Chocolate Round Leather Cord (SM5070)

5 feet - Brown One-G Beading Thread (SM5252)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

Size 11 Tulip Beading Needles (TL2648)

Hypo Tube Cement (TL1202)

Xuron Thread and Fiber Scissors (TL3000)

Clipboard

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Wrapped Cord Bracelet

## **Instructions to complete “Jewel Point it Out” bracelet:**

### ***Tips***

*The letters A – C designate the beads used in the pattern. Please refer to the materials list above for the key. The bracelet is made with a variation of the Wrapped Cord Bracelet using 2-hole beads.*

### **Step 1**

Using scissors cut a 48-inch length of cord.

### **Step 2**

String the button onto the cord to the middle of the cord. Tie an overhand knot just below the button. Clip the button to a clip board (see Wrapped Cord Bracelet Technique).

### **Step 3**

Thread a needle with 5 feet of beading thread. Attach the thread to the cord.

### **Step 4**

String 2 – A, wrap the cord, and pass back down the same two holes used previously. Wrap the cord, pass up the second hole of the first A, string 2 – B, and pass up the second hole of the second A. Wrap the cord.

### **Step 5**

Pass back down through the four beads from the previous step in this sequence: first hole of 1 – B, second hole of 2 – A and first hole of 1 – B.

### **Step 6**

Repeat Steps 4 – 5.

### **Step 7**

String 2 – A, wrap the cord, and pass back down the same two holes used previously. Wrap the cord, pass up the second hole of the first A, string 2 – C, and pass up the second hole of the second A. Wrap the cord.

### **Step 8**

Pass back down through the four beads from the previous step in this sequence: first hole of the 2 – C, second hole of the 2 – A.

### **Step 9**

Repeat Steps 4 – 5 using only C four times.

### **Step 10**

Repeat the entire pattern of Steps 4 – 9 five times.

### **Step 11**

Finish off the beading thread according to the Technique.

### **Step 12**

Trim excess thread with scissors. Apply a drop of glue on each thread knot. Allow the glue to dry.

### **Step 13**

Tie an overhand knot after the last bead. Make one buttonhole according to the Technique. Trim excess cord.
