

# Happy Pumpkin by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 18 inches necklace

## **Beads and other products needed for one pin/necklace:**

- 1 - Size 11 Peach Bellini Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2351 (11DB2351) **(B)**
- 1 - Size 11 Cheddar Orange Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2104 (11DB2104) **(E)**
- 1 - Size 11 Opaque Black Delica Beads - DB0010 (11DB0010) **(A)**
- 1 - Size 11 Cinnamon Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2109 (11DB2109) **(D)**
- 1 - Size 11 Opaque White Delica Beads - DB0200 (11DB0200) **(C)**
- 1 - 26.5mm Silver Plated Base Metal Bar Pin with Bail (BM3428)
- 1 - 18 Inch Nickel Plated Steel 2mm Ball Chain Necklace (CN4159)
- 1 - Black Satin FireLine Braided Bead Thread - 6 lb - .006in - 15 yard spool (SM6353)

## **Tools needed to complete the pin/necklace:**

Size 11 Tulip Beading Needles  
Xuron Thread and Fiber Scissors  
Xuron Thread and Fiber Scissors (TL3000)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the pin/necklace:**

Flat, Odd Count Peyote Stitch  
Flat, Odd Count Peyote Stitch - Decreasing

## Instructions to complete "Happy Pumpkin" pin/necklace:

### **Step 1**

Thread a needle with 4 feet of beading thread. Starting from the center, widest part of the Pumpkin follow the graph pattern below to weave the Pumpkin in Peyote stitch. (see Flat, Odd Count Peyote Stitch and Flat, Odd Count Peyote Stitch- Decreasing)

### **Step 2**

Tie a stop bead on your thread at about the center point of your thread. String the following beads to start your Pumpkin. Follow the pattern below and graph provided to weave your way down the Pumpkin–

Rows 1, 2 – 1E, 1D, 3E, 2A, 1C, 2A, 7E, 2A, 1C, 2A, 3E, 1D, 1E

Row 3 – 2E, 3A, 4E, 3A, 2E

Row 4 – 1D, 1E, 4A, 1E, 4A, 1E, 1D

Row 5 – 3E, 2A, 1E, 2A, 1E, 2A, 3E

Row 6 - 1D, 1E, 1D, 1A, 2E, 1A, 2E, 1A, 1D, 1E, 1D

Row 7 - 1E, 1D, 10E, 1D, 1E

Row 8 - 2E, 1D, 1B, 5E, 1B, 1D, 2E

Row 9 - 1E, 1D, 1E, 2B, 4E, 2B, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 10 - 1E, 1D, 1E, 1B, 5E, 1B, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 11 – decrease, 2E, 2B, 4E, 2B, 2E

Row 12 - 1E, 1D, 1E, 1B, 5E, 1B, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 13 – decrease, 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 4E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 14 – decrease, 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 3E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 15 – decrease, 1E, 1D, 6E, 1D, 1E

Row 16 – decrease, 9E

Row 17 – decrease, 8E

### **Step 3**

Weave the thread ends through several rows, and trim the thread.

### **Step 4**

Remove your stop bead and thread your needle on the other side of your beading thread. You will need to weave your thread around so that you are coming out of the first E bead you strung in step 2 so that you can work your way across the Pumpkin from left to right. Continuing Peyote Stitch up to the top of the Pumpkin, weave the following pattern, follow the graph provided.

Row 18 - 1D, 1E, 2A, 5E, 2A, 1E, 1D

Row 19 - 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 6E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 20 – decrease, 13E

Row 21 - 1D, 1E, 1D, 6E, 1D, 1E, 1D

Row 22 - 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 5E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 23 – decrease, 12E

Row 24 - 1D, 1E, 1D, 5E, 1D, 1E, 1D

Row 25 - 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 4E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E

Row 26 – decrease, 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E, 1D, 1E, 1E

Row 27 – decrease, 1E, 1D, 2E, 2D, 2E, 1D, 1E

Row 28 – decrease, 3E, 1Blank, 1D, 1Blank, 3E

Row 29 – decrease, 2E, 1Blank, 2D, 1Blank, 2E

Row 30 - 1D

Row 31- 2D

Row 32 - 2D






Row 33 - 1D

Row 34 - 1D

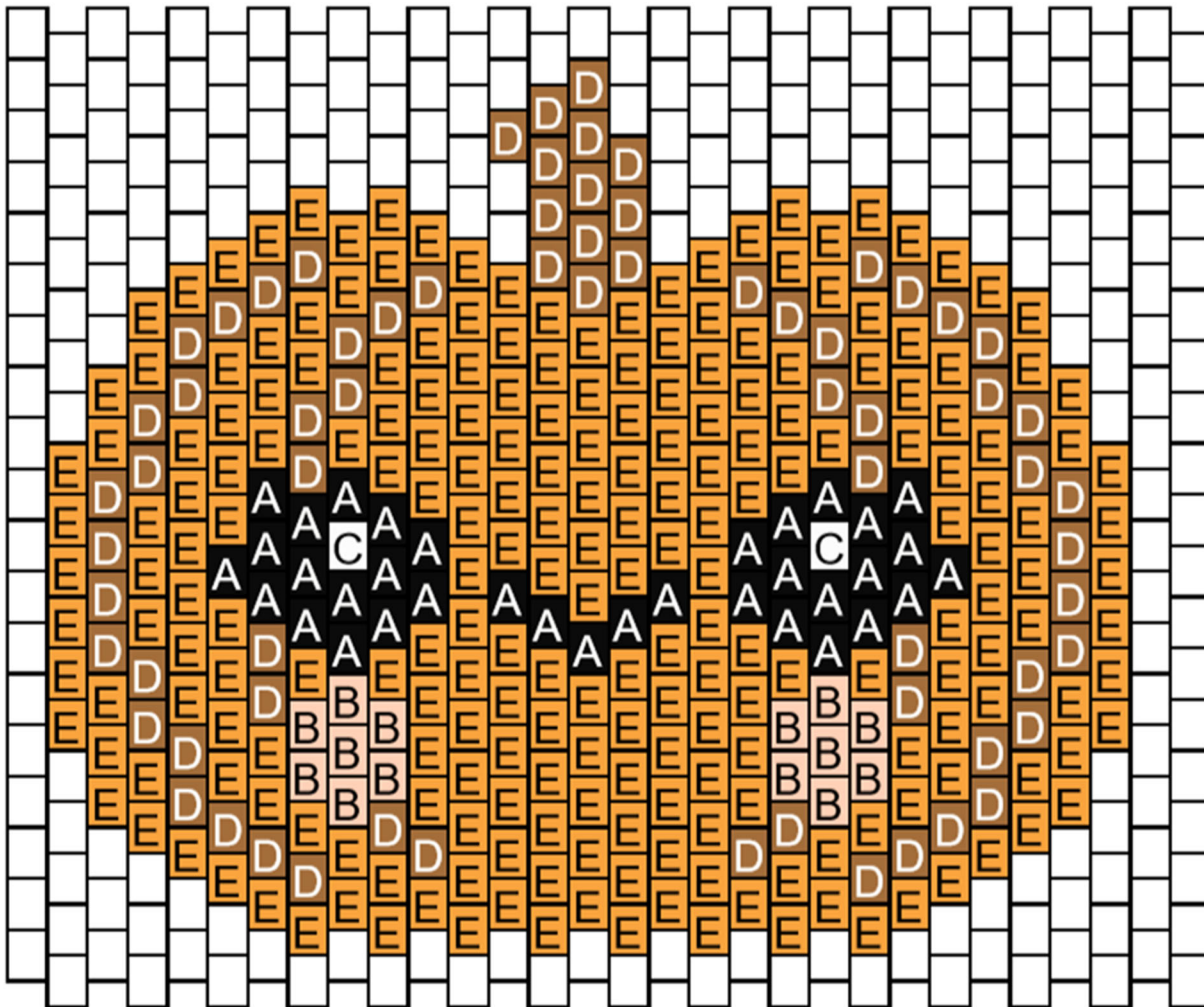
### **Step 5**

Weave remaining thread back through the stem of the pumpkin and down to the eye area. Using the remaining thread, tack on the pin back by weaving your thread through the holes of the pin back and back through the beads. Tack down on both sides of the pin back, top and bottom. Weave the thread end through several rows and out one side, and trim the thread.
